



You are Invited to Attend a Public Forum About Kenilworth's National Register Nomination

Please reserve the evening of Tuesday, May 27, 2008 for a public forum, hosted by the Village Board Community Affairs Committee. At this forum, the Village's consultants, Theodore Hild and Susan Benjamin, will provide a presentation on the draft nomination seeking to designate the entire Village as a National Register Historic District. The presentation will include a physical description of the district; the story of why the Village is architecturally and historically important; an explanation of what a National Register listing means for individual property owners; and information about how property owners can submit their approval or objection to the creation of a National Register District. At the end of 2007, after years of study, the Kenilworth Village Board decided to pursue an honorary and *nonrestrictive* National Register historic district for the whole Village. The Village Board chose this approach as a positive, non-regulatory way to celebrate Kenilworth's rich history and architectural resources. The upcoming forum will be an opportunity for all residents to discuss and learn more about Kenilworth's heritage and the National Register of Historic Places.
