National Register of Historic Places Historic District

- A national “honor roll”; not a program.
- Non-regulatory – No review of individual homeowner projects unless property owner decides to participate in State or Federal incentive programs and meet certain requirements.
- Not a local program, no local preservation or district ordinance required.
- No regulatory body (no local Preservation Commission).
- Designated at the national level.
- No restrictions, no review of changes, and no prohibition of demolition related to the National Register unless project receives Federal or State funding.

VS.

Local Historic District/Preservation Ordinance*

- Ongoing preservation program created and administered by the municipality.
- May be regulatory in nature.
- Requires a local Preservation Ordinance
- Most have a municipal review body (Historic Preservation Commission).
- Local landmarks are designated by the municipality – municipality determines who has authority to submit local landmark nominations.
- Changes to structures and/or demolition may require review and approval of the historic preservation commission.

* A range of options determined by each municipality.
