

REVISED Timeline – Village of Kenilworth National Register District Nomination (Village President Veto Overridden)

August 5, 2008	Regular Village Board Meeting – Village Board votes to approve ordinance and direct the submittal of the Village of Kenilworth National Register District Nomination over the Village President’s Objections.
August 6, 2008	Village Manager takes action to forward nomination to State of Illinois Historic Preservation Office for review.
August 6 – November 5, 2008	Draft Nomination Received and Reviewed by State Historic Preservation Office. Changes may be made at this time. Nomination can be withdrawn at any time at the Village Board’s request.
August 18, 2008	Last day for filing petitions for referenda for the submission of questions of public policy.
September 2, 2008	Last day for County, Municipal, Township and Park Boards to place advisory referenda on the ballot by resolution.
September 5, 2008	Last Day Illinois Historic Preservation Agency will accept completed National Register nominations for consideration at December Illinois Historic Sites Advisory Council meeting.
September 8, 2008	Regular Village Board Meeting
October 13, 2008	Regular Village Board Meeting
Approximately October 30, 2008	Illinois Historic Preservation Agency publishes public notice of the consideration of the proposed district at December meeting of the Illinois Historic Sites Advisory Council (Wilmette Life).
Approximately November 1, 2008	Courtesy letter sent to all property owners detailing process for approving or objecting to the establishment of the National Register District. <i>(Not more than 75 days and not less than 30 days before Illinois Sites Advisory Council meeting.)</i> Courtesy letter sent to person or entity receiving the tax bill for each property within the Village.

November 4, 2008	Election Day – Resident Initiated Advisory Referendum Question on Ballot: “Shall the Village of Kenilworth nominate all of the lands and structures within its municipal boundaries, regardless of private or public ownership, for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places?” Election results unofficial until review by Cook County Canvassing Board.
November 5, 2008	Illinois Historic Preservation Agency sets agenda for December 5, 2008 Illinois Sites Advisory Council meeting. Nomination materials to be considered by the Advisory Council at December meeting sent to council members. Nominations in process that are not complete or need extensive revisions will not move forward to the December Illinois Sites Advisory Council meeting after this date.
November 10, 2008	Regular Village Board Meeting
November 21, 2008 - Noon	Last day Village of Kenilworth can submit a letter to Illinois Historic Preservation Agency requesting National Register District nomination be either withdrawn or deferred from consideration at December 5, 2008 Illinois Historic Sites Advisory Council (ISAC) meeting. At the ISAC meeting there would have to be a motion, a second, and a vote to approve the request for deferral or withdrawal.
December 5, 2008	Illinois Historic Sites Advisory Council meeting – Springfield, Illinois
December 8, 2008	Regular Village Board Meeting
December 12, 2008	Approximate date Illinois Historic Preservation Agency sends nomination to National Park Service in Washington, D.C.
January 24, 2009	Approximate date for listing the proposed Kenilworth National Register Historic District on the National Register.
