Village Expands Recycling Services

In response to resident input, the Village Board has investigated how best to improve its recycling services along with the renewal of the Perrin Brothers contract. The Board has decided to renew the Perrin Contract (this was never in question) and to continue the use of recycling bags. However, the Board has clarified what can be recycled and has made recycling bags available 24 hours a day. The Board will continue to monitor the effectiveness of the program.

1. RECYCLABLE MATERIALS ADDED TO PROGRAM

Residents can place any of the recyclable material listed on the recycling bags. New bags with the updated list will be available at Village Hall once the old bags have been used up. Please note that materials containing food waste or styrofoam are not considered recyclable.

2. RECYCLING BAG AVAILABILITY

Bags are now available in the Village Hall lobby 24 hours a day in order for residents to pick up bags after business hours and weekends. Residents are asked to sign in on the appropriate sheet at the front counter and are limited to two bundles per visit.

3. LANDSCAPE WASTE BAG ADDITIONS

Lawn waste pick up will begin April 1, 2009. Residents can now use any kraft paper yard waste bag to dispose of landscape waste. Residents are no longer required to purchase only Kenilworth yard waste bags at the Village hall. Yard waste bags are available for purchase at most retail, hardware and grocery stores including, but not limited to Jewel, Dominick's, Walgreens, Home Depot and Menards. Lawn bags will continue to be sold at Village Hall while supplies last. Please note that recycling bags are NOT acceptable to use for lawn waste removal.

The Following Items Can Now Be Recycled in Kenilworth



Aerosol Cans – empty	Cardboard
Aluminum Cans	Cereal boxes

How to Prepare Materials for Recycling

Precycle - Avoid buying products in containers that cannot be recycled in the program.

- Rinse out all bottles, cans and containers.
- The plastic cap can be put back on milk jugs and water/pop bottles after rinsing them out.
- Steel lids from glass jars can be recycled – just remove from container.
- Flatten cardboard boxes and larger containers.

DO NOT include anything that may contaminate the recyclable materials, such as:

- Animal Waste
- Broken or non-traditional glass (ceramic, light bulbs, mirrors, window panes, etc.)
- Garbage
- Greasy pizza boxes
- Hazardous Waste
- Messy food containers
